



# US 163 Little Capitan Valley

## STORM WATER DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

### OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration are making roadway improvements along a 1-mile stretch of US 163, approximately 5 miles north of Kayenta, in Little Capitan Valley. The purpose of project is to improve storm water drainage during periods of rain. Work on the \$3.75 million project is scheduled to begin in mid-March 2018 and continue for approximately six months.

Work will occur between mileposts 400 and 401 and includes removing the existing pavement; extending the pipe culvert that carries storm water under the roadway; and then repaving.

### TRAFFIC

Drivers should expect periodic closures on US 163 and intermittent delays of up to 30 minutes. There will be a temporary detour for drivers to use for north- and southbound travel on the highway while work is underway.
